



## Crochet Mug Cozy

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy

**SIZE:**

One Size (FINISHED DIMENSIONS: 15 3/4" x 3 1/2", FITS MUG SIZE: 4 1/4" diameter x 4" tall)

**MATERIALS NEEDED:**

Yarn: Medium weight, Worsted weight 100% acrylic yarn (pictures with "Pound of Love")

Button: This project also requires a button that will fit tightly through the button hole (pictured with a 1" diameter button)

Crochet Hook Size: I/9 - 5.50mm

**GAUGE:** 11 sc = 3 1/2"

**STITCH EXPLANATION:**

CH = chain

SC = single crochet 2 stitches together

ST = stitch

SC2TOG = single crochet

SLST = slip stitch

DC = double crochet

**NOTES:** Pattern is worked from side with the handle hole to the strip with the button hole.

**PATTERN:**

Ch 12

Row 1: sc in the 2nd ch from the hook, sc all remaining st, ch 1, turn (11)

Row 2: sc in all st across, ch 1 (11)

Row 3: sc in all st across, ch 1 (11)

Row 4: sc, ch 11, skip next 10 stitches, sc in last stitch of the row, ch 1 (12) (forms the hole for the handle)

Row 5: sc in first 5 st (sc and 4 ch from previous row), sc2tog next 2 ch st, sc in next 5 st (4 ch and 1 sc from previous row), ch 1 (11)

Row 6: sc in all st across, ch 1 (11)

Rows 7-44: Repeat Row 6

Row 45: slst in first 3 st, sc in next 5 st (leave remaining stitches unworked), ch 1

Row 46: sc in all sc st from previous row, ch 1 (5)

Row 47-52: Repeat row 46

Row 53: sc in first st, slst next 3 sc, sc in last stitch, ch 1 (5) (shaping button hole)

Row 54: sc in first st, ch 3, skip next 3 st, sc in last stitch (5)

Row 55: sc in all st across, ch 2 (5)

Row 56: sk next 2 st, in 3rd st work 5 dc in the same stitch, ch 2, slst in last stitch. Fasten off.

Weave in ends. Shape around the mug to determine placement of button. Be sure the button will fit into the button hole securely and allow for the cozy to fit tightly around the mug enough that it will not shift when picked up. Attach button.

The final cozy can be washed according to instructions listed on the skein used and is removable.
